PALMA'S BIG TRIAL



One of the biggest trials in Spanish legal history opens in Palma on Monday involving King's Felipe's brother-in-law, Iñaki Urdangarin and his business partner, Diego Torres, who are charged with embezzling six million euros of public funds. The King's sister, the Infanta Cristina, is also expected to appear in the make-shift court which has been set-up on the industrial estate next to Palma prison. *Left*, judge's court dress are wheeled into the building and *above* tight security for the trial which will last for months.
