Police launch probe after body of woman found in Arenal: Inside

CARGO SHIP HORROR

Spanish emergency services evacuated the crew of Italian-flagged vehicle transport ship *Grande Europa*, which caught fire 25 miles south of the main city of Palma yesterday. Fifteen crew were taken off the ship while the rest remained onboard helping to combat the fire. Two helicopters and three boats were taking part in the rescue effort. It was not yet clear what had caused the fire, the services said. **See Inside.**



May's Brexit deal is "dead"

London.—Prime Minister Theresa May's Brexit deal with Brussels will be dead in its current form if parliament rejects it for a fourth time next month, Brexit minister Stephen Barclay said yesterday.

The government said on Tuesday it planned to bring forward the Withdrawal Agreement Bill (WAB), the legislation required to ratify May's exit deal, early next month. Lawmakers will get to vote on it the week of June 3.



Asked by a committee of lawmakers from the upper house of parliament if this was the last chance saloon for May's divorce deal, Barclay said: "If the House of Commons does not approve the WAB, then the Barnier deal is dead in that form and the House will have to then address a fundamental question between whether it will pursue and communicate on a no-deal option or whether it will revoke."
