British tourism weathers Brexit storm



● Number of holidaymakers from Britain to Balearics set to fall by four percent, which is better than many had forecast, and growing concern over German market which is set to fall by eight percent.

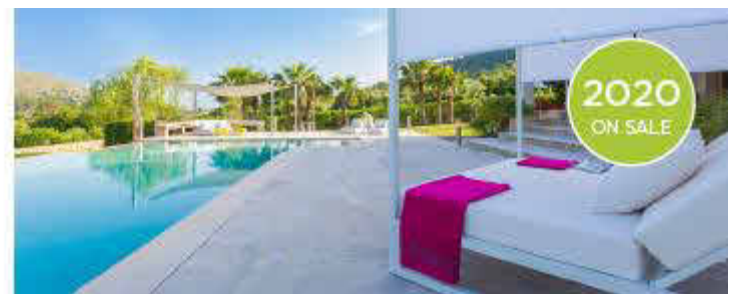
Palma.—A big fall in the number of British tourists coming to the island this summer had been forecast because of the drop in the value of sterling against the euro and greater competition from cheaper resorts in North Africa and Turkey...but it appears that the doom and gloom merchants were wrong. British tourism is set to fall by four percent; still a drop but not as big as

many had forecast at the start of the season. But what is causing concern is the German market with a fall of eight percent being forecast. Millions of Germans come on holiday to the Balearics and therefore an eight percent drop is quite a significant fall. There is concern within the tourist industry and hoteliers have been forced to cut prices.
