Fears that Spain won't be on Britain's Green List

P rime Minister Boris Johnson says he won't be adding more destinations to the UK's 'Green' list any time soon, because of the rise in Indian variant cases in the UK, according to

the *Sun* newspaper. "There is a very limited list as you know and we will make sure that people travelling abroad will be subject to all the tests and restraints that people would expect to prevent the virus from

being reimported," said Johnson. "It's such a tiny list of countries and I don't expect we'll be adding to it very rapidly." It's a huge blow for the Tourism Sector in Majorca which has been counting on there being an in-

flux of Brits in June, but it looks like they'll have to wait until July or August. Majorca and Spain are currently on the 'Amber' list which means that British tourists would have to quarantine.

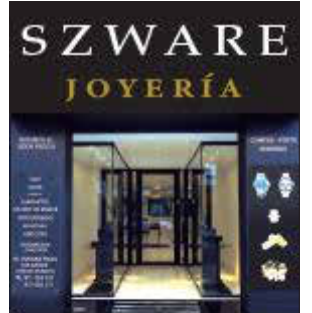
New Covid plan

London.— Prime Minister Boris Johnson said yesterday Britain would accelerate its COVID-19 vaccination programme, to try to contain a fast-spreading variant first identified in India that could knock a re-opening of the economy off track.

The United Kingdom has delivered one of the world's fastest inoculation campaigns, giving a first shot to almost 70% of the adult population and a second to 36%, helping to reduce infection rates and deaths. But the emergence of the B.1.617.2 variant in parts of northern England and London has prompted some scientists to call for the reopening to be delayed.
