## Suicide threat

● Survivors of a mass food poisoning four decades ago occupied Madrid's El Prado art gallery for a few hours yesterday, threatening to commit suicide if their demands for aid and attention were unmet. A photo showed six people - one in a wheelchair - holding a banner in front of "Las Meninas", a painting by Spanish painter Diego Velazquez. Others gathered outside.

Police detained two of the protesters and the others left the museum.
