London.—Britain's Queen Elizabeth, 95, was back at her desk at Windsor Castle yesterday after she spent a night in hospital for the first time in years for what Buckingham Palace termed "preliminary investigations".

The world's oldest and longest-reigning monarch stayed in hospital overnight on Wednesday but returned to Windsor Castle to the west of London the following day, with officials saying she was in good spirits and back at work.

Like many other holidaymakers, Jack Ma the Chinese billionaire, arrived on the island on a Boeing jet airliner. But in his case the Boeing 737 is his own private jet...no duty free just super luxury. The Alibaba Group founder, like other tourists, went on a cruise around the islands. In his case it wasn't a glass bottom-boat but the superyacht *Zen*, a sleek five-deck, vertical-bowed motor yacht, measuring 88 metres (289 ft),

which can accommodate up to 16 guests and a crew of 25. Apart from sailing and some sight-seeing he spent a large part of his Majorca holiday playing golf. Yesterday, he left the island on his jet, which is too big to park up at the private jet terminal. There had been some speculation that Ma had "disappeared" after criticising the Chinese authorities. In Majorca he didn't miss out on anything and he certainly hasn't disappeared.
