A MOORING IN PALMA FIT FOR A QUEEN



THE Royal Navy flagship, *Queen Elizabeth*, finally entered the Port of Palma yesterday after being anchored in the Bay. There was simply not enough room in the port on Thursday for the flagship to dock so she spent the night at anchor. Unlike, her arrival on Thursday, which was hit by bad weather, she docked in the port yesterday in brilliant sunshine. Scores of her crew went on sight-seeing tours of the island, while others returned home after the long deployment. Some families

of the crew had flown out to the island to enjoy some Majorca magic with their loved ones. The aircraft carrier will remain in port until Tuesday when she will start the last leg of her deployment with a visit to the Spanish naval base at Rota. Then it will be home to Portsmouth in time for Christmas. On her deck her state-of-the-art F35 jets were clearly visible along with Merlin helicopters. The last *HMS Queen Elizabeth* to visit Palma was a battleship more than 100 years to the day.
