GLOBAL ALARM

The discovery of a new coronavirus variant triggered global alarm as Europe rushed to suspend travel from southern Africa and stock markets on both sides of the Atlantic suffered their biggest falls in more than a year. The World Health Organisation (WHO) said it

was designating the variant, named omicron, as being “of concern,” a label only given to four variants to date. But it could take weeks for scientists to fully understand the variant’s mutations. Health authorities are seeking to determine if omicron is more transmissible or infectious than other vari-

ants and if vaccines are effective against it. “Bus to a hall to a huge queue. I can see COVID testers in bright blue PPE far on the distance. Still no snacks for the sad babies,” tweeted *New York Times* journalist Stephanie Nolen, a passenger on the flight from Johannesburg.
