Electric scooter riders told: **GET OFF THE PAVEMENT**

- Cyclists will have to wear safety helmets at all times, according to new tough traffic laws.
- Don't use your mobile phone while driving.

Electric scooter riders have been ordered off the pavement and from pedestrianised zones in tough new traffic laws which come into force in March, the Spanish government announced this morning.

Electric scooters have been in the spotlight after a string of serious accidents across Majorca. Bike riders will also have to wear a safety helmet at all times. Using your mobile telephone while driving (without a hands free device) will be

punished with a heavy fine by police.

Throwing an object from a moving car window can cost you a 500 euro spot fine. You will lose four points on your licence if you do not properly use the safety belt.



MAJORCA FREEZES AGAIN AS TEMPERATURES FALL TO -5

Palma.—It was another freezing night on Majorca with temperatures falling to -5 degrees in Escorca. Even Palma was cold registering -1.3 degrees.

It has already gone down on record as one

of the coldest winters in the Balearics, according to the Met Office.
