Abramovich yacht leaves Barcelona

Barcelona. A super yacht linked to Russian oligarch Roman Abramovich left Barcelona this week where it had been undergoing repairs in a local shipyard, ship-tracking data showed. The 140-metre (460-foot) *Solaris*, which sails under a Bermuda flag according to monitoring site Marine Traffic, left Spanish company MB92's Barcelona shipyard just after 5 p.m. on Tuesday, according to the same site. MB92 declined to comment.

Spanish court backs Twitter ban over messages

Madrid.—Spain's Supreme Court ruled on Tuesday that Twitter's temporary suspension of the far-right Vox party's account last year after it posted anti-immigrant messages was reasonable and proportional. Twitter banned Vox from posting for eight days last January after the party tweeted that immigrants of Maghrebi origin were responsible for the vast majority of crimes committed in the Catalonia region, shortly before local elections were held. The social-media giant said the post incited hatred against the immigrant community.
