Transport crisis places Balearics in the slow lane



Palma.—The transport crisis is strangling the holiday season this summer, the tourist industry has warned.

A lack of taxis and buses coupled with a shortage of staff at the airport is causing numerous headaches for the industry, which can't cope with the demand. Forecasts indicated that summer 2022 would be far better

than 2019, which was already considered a record year. But the islands appear to be a victim of their own success. In some resorts the wait for a taxi is up to 60 minutes. The problem has become so pronounced that there have been many cases of tourists missing their flights simply because they couldn't get to the airport. The President of the Hoteliers Federa-

tion, Maria Frontera, has said that the flight cancellations and long delays at the airport are causing late-bookers to have second thoughts.

She called on the Balearic government to improve the public transport network. There are already calls across the island for more taxi licences to be granted, but so far they have fallen on deaf ears.
